Your love of God's soil has passed on to your kin; the stories flow like fine wine,

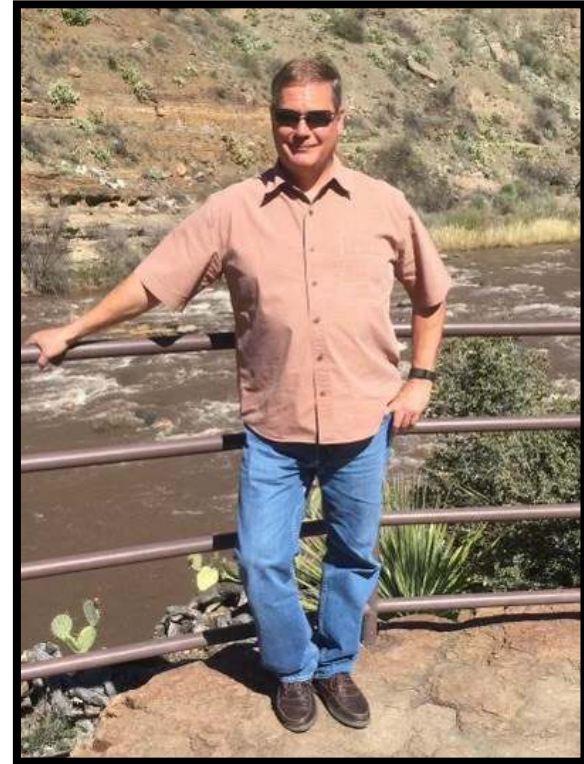
Wash off your work boots in the puddle left by blessed rain one final time.
