

Schanina "Nina" Feather, age 36, died on Sunday, May 26th, 2024 in Minneapolis, MN.

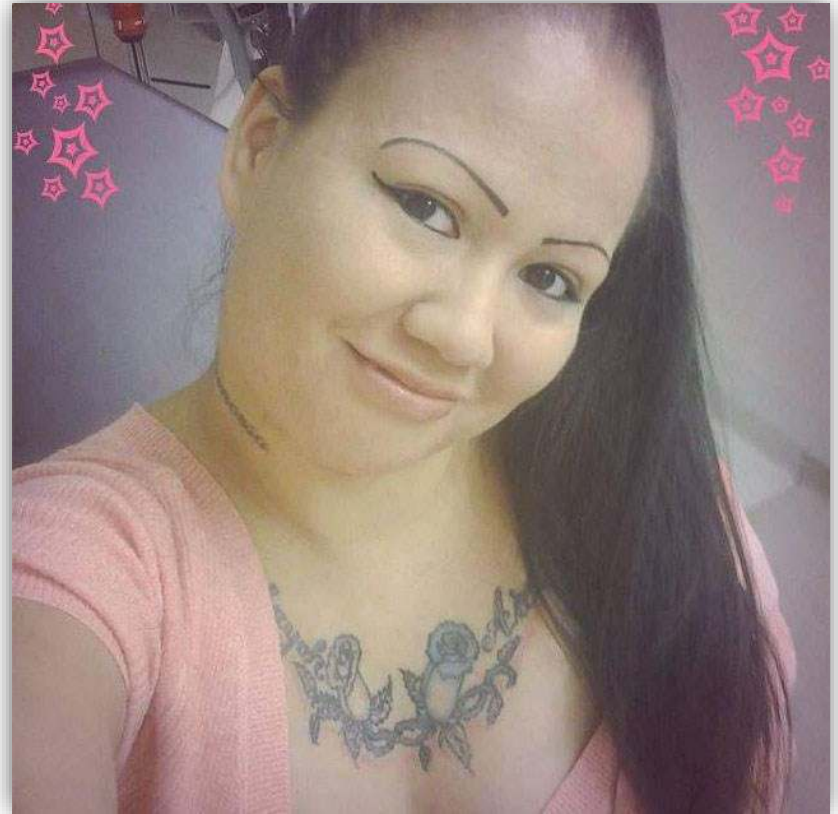
