Warren Francis Dalbec was born in Bismarck, ND, on July 2, 1956, the son of Francis and Irene (Nye) Dalbec. He grew up in Wing and attended school there until the 8th grade. His father worked as a Rural Mail Carrier and at that time was transferred to Cooperstown, ND, where Warren graduated from high school. He then went on to North Dakota State School of Science in Wahpeton, ND, to be an Auto Mechanic. His first job after graduating was at Farmer's Union Oil in Rolla, where he met Jolene Hamley through a mutual friend.
